

## **PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION TO UG/PG COURSES 2017-2018**

The admission procedures are as per the norms given by Government of Tamil Nadu.

- Admission is made purely on merit basis.
- The Admission process is very transparent.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- UG – Candidates must have passed plus two examinations
- PG – Candidates must have passed 3 years degree course

### **ISSUE OF APPLICATION FORMS:**

- Application forms for admission are issued before 5 days from the date of publication

/Internet –Website results of Higher Secondary Examination of Tamil Nadu.

### **LAST DATE FOR THE RECEIPT OF COMPLETED APPLICATIONS:**

- Last date for receipt of filled in applications by the College is fixed as the tenth day from the date of publication of Results.
- College will prepare the Rank list for Admission and is pasted on the Notice Board on 14<sup>th</sup> day.
- Counselling is conducted between 15<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> days.

### **SELECTION COMMITTEE:**

The Selection Committee consists of the Principal, two senior most Associate Professors, and the senior most belonging to SC/ST of the College.

### **RULE OF RESERVATION:**

The admission is made purely on the basis of Merit subject to the rule of reservation of the Government of Tamil Nadu.

- 1) 31% for Open Competition (OC)
- 2) 30% for Backward classes (BC) within this 3.5% is earmarked for Muslims.
- 3) 20% for Most Backward classes (MBC) and Denotified Communities (DNC)
- 4) IN the 18% for Scheduled Castes(SC), 3% of seats offered to Arunthathiyar (within the seats reserved for SC)
- 5) 1% for Scheduled Tribes(ST)

### **Quota For Differently Abled**

- Out of the quota of 19% reserved for SC/ST, 3 out of every 100 seats will be reserved
- Out of the quota for 50% (30% BC and 20% MBC/DNC 3 out of every 100 seats will be reserved.
- Out of the quota of 31% intended for open competition, 3 out of every 100 seats will be reserved.

Quota for Ex-Serviceman:

- Six seats in UG and 3 seats in PG courses will be reserved for the children of Ex-servicemen of Tamil Nadu Origin.

Quota for Outstanding Sports/NCC Candidates:

- 3% of seats in UG courses and 2% of seats in PG courses are reserved under Sports Quota for students, who have represented at the District Level/Divisional Level and above.
- One seat in UG courses for “A” Certificate holders and 1 seat in PG courses with “C” Certificate holders is reserved for NCC Cadets.
